Dear Juanita and David:

As discussed and as agreed, today we filed a Privacy Act lawsuit which names The Executive Office of the President and the United States Justice Department. The thrust of our case is to obtain your files. We did not name Lanny Davis as a defendant. However, the statement which he made on FOX News the other evening, was quite helpful to show that The White House and FBI likely have access to your file.

As also discussed, we will use our discretion as to how this should be publicized when we get press calls. We did not issue a press release. Instead, CNN apparently picked it up from the courthouse filing, and the news then spread to NBC and FOX. This is normal and to be expected.

We will keep you apprised of all developments, and we are pleased to be of assistance.
