SHE HAS NEVER BEEN ABLE TO CONFRONT THIS HORRIBLE EVENT FOR HERSELF. SHE HAS ONLY TALKED ABOUT IT TO CLOSE FRIENDS OR WHEN IT WAS OFFICIAL INFORMATION IN SOME LEGAL MATTER.

THIS IS THE FIRST TIME SINCE IT HAPPENED THAT SHE HAS TALKED ABOUT IT FOR HERSELF.

I HAVE HAD THE THOUGHT THAT THE TERROR OF THE CLINTON INCOUNTER WOULD LAST THROUGHOUT JUANITA'S LIFETIME.

NOW, I HOPE THE HEALING WILL CONTINUE, AND SHE IS HEALED FOR THE REST OF HER LIFE. I KNOW IT'S A BIG WISH. I LOVE HER.
